**North Region Weigh-In Procedures will be strictly enforced – see below**

Gate: Adults - \$2.00, Students - \$1.00, Children 5 and under free.

Child abuse, Offensive Language, Disorderly Conduct, etc will not be tolerated and will be dealt with severely.

## **Texas USA Wrestling, North Region Weigh-in Procedures**

1. The tournament director shall coordinate and provide notice throughout the region of the time and location of the weigh-in(s) and see that these procedures are followed.
2. When multiple weigh-ins are provided, wrestlers may choose any weigh-in appropriate with the division and weight class entered but are allowed only ONE weigh-in opportunity. This opportunity occurs when the wrestler steps on any weigh-in scale. The results of this one weigh-in will count for any multiple entries for all sessions of the tournament.
3. Wrestlers are allowed to step on and off the scale two times to compensate for any mechanical inconsistencies in the scale. Wrestlers are also allowed to step on any other weigh-in scale(s) in use for the tournament provided that they are escorted by an official to each additional scale. Absolutely no weight cutting of any kind is allowed at the weigh-in.
4. North Region policy strongly encourages tournament directors to bump and re-bracket for all wrestlers who bust weight. However, circumstances may make re-bracketing impractical or disruptive to the tournament schedule. In such cases, wrestlers who bust weight will be scratched from the tournament with no refund.
5. Regional qualifiers will be based upon the actual weight from the one weigh-in. The tournament will NOT count as a qualifier for scratched wrestlers.
6. A TXUSAW Official must conduct the weigh-in with certified scales. A check scale may be provided at the discretion of the tournament director.
7. The wrestler's actual weight, division and classification should be written with a black sharpie on the upper right arm - ex. **D3 OPEN 64.7**.
8. A one pound growth allowance will be added to Tots thru Division 3 beginning January 1. A two pound growth allowance will be added to Divisions 4 and 5 beginning January 1.
9. All wrestlers shall weigh-in wearing a competition singlet.
10. All wrestlers should be checked for contagious skin conditions. We will only accept the NFHS Physician Release with doctor's original signature. These forms need to be presented to the head official prior to competition. Fingernails shall be properly clipped. Hair shall conform to NFHS rules.
